## Rates Remission Applications Storm Damaged Property

Council has established a subcommittee to consider applications for a partial rate remission (rate relief) for properties severely damaged by Cyclone Ita (Easter storm) and the recent Blaketown tornado (2 August). Applications will only be considered for those properties that have been deemed uninhabitable for an extended period and have suffered uninsured losses.

The subcommittee will consider a partial remission of the general rates payable for 2014/2015.

Completed application forms must be received no later than **5.00PM 29 August 2014**.
