

Decision No. GREYDLC002/2019

IN THE MATTER

of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act)

AND

IN THE MATTER

of an application by **DEEPAK SHARMA** pursuant to s.224 of the Act for a Renewal of a General Manager's Certificate

BEFORE THE GREY DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

This is an application by Deepak Sharma for a renewal of a manager's certificate to manage licenced premises known as the Zaika Moroccan Ltd Greymouth.

It was filed with the Grey District Council and is to be considered under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and by the District Licensing Committee.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant holds the Licence Controller Qualification. The applicant has previously held a General Manager's Certificate under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector has opposed this application. No undertakings are sought by the agencies however it is noted the applicant's work visa expires on 14 November 2020, within the three year period of renewal. In a signed undertaking the applicant agrees not to use the certificate beyond that date unless he further renews his visa and also to only use the certificate to manage the Zaika Moroccan grill and bar.

Accordingly the application is dealt with on the papers.

DECISION

The application and supporting information satisfies the committee that the criteria we must have in regard to as set out in s227 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 grants an application Deepak Sharma for a renewal of a Manager's Certificate on the express condition that he not use the certificate beyond 14 November 2020 unless he extends his Working Visa and provides a copy to the Grey District Licensing Committee before that date.

Further the certificate is tagged to the Zaika Moroccan Ltd trading as Zaika Moroccan Grill and Bar.
