This is an application by Emily Rose Kavanagh for a renewal of a manager's certificate to manage licenced premises known as The Australasian Hotel.

It was filed with the Grey District Council and is to be considered under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and by the District Licensing Committee.

**REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The applicant holds the Licence Controller Qualification. The applicant has previously held a General Manager's Certificate under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
