**BEFORE THE GREY DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE**

This is an application by Jason Edward Johnson for a manager's certificate to manage licensed premises known as Hopaholics Brewery..

Pursuant to s222 of the Act this application is to be considered under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and by the District Licensing Committee.

**REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The applicant holds the Licence Controller Qualification and is employed on licensed premises.

The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's experience in controlling licensed premises and has tested his understanding of his responsibilities as a manager.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concern about the suitability of the applicant nor do they oppose the granting of the application. No undertakings are sought by the agencies.

Accordingly the application is dealt with on the papers.

**DECISION**

The application and supporting information satisfies the committee that the criteria it must have in regard to as set out in s222 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Jason Edward Johnson for a Manager's Certificate.

The Certificate is valid for twelve months from the date the certificate is issued.
