

Decision No. GREYDLC112/2020

IN THE MATTER

of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act)

AND

IN THE MATTER

of an application by **ANTHONY JOHN TRAVIS** pursuant to s.219 of the Act for a Manager's Certificate

BEFORE THE GREY DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

This is an application by Anthony John Travis for a manager's certificate to manage licensed premises known as the Edge of the Alps – Woodstock Grill, Greymouth.

Pursuant to s222 of the Act this application is to be considered under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and by the District Licensing Committee.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant holds the Licence Controller Qualification and is employed on licensed premises.

The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's experience in controlling licensed premises and has tested his understanding of his responsibilities as a manager.

Although the NZ Police and the Licensing Inspector do not object to this application or to the suitability of the applicant, the applicant's historical criminal history and the previous Licensing Committee decision GREYDLC247/2017 has been noted.

Accordingly the application is dealt with on the papers.

DECISION

The application and supporting information satisfies the committee that the criteria it must have in regard to as set out in s222 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Anthony John Travis for a Manager's Certificate.

The Certificate is valid for twelve months from the date the certificate is issued.
