

Decision No. GREYDLC 017/2021

of an application **JASON EDWARD JOHNSON** pursuant to s.224 of the Act for a Renewal of a General Manager's Certificate

BEFORE THE GREY DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

This is an application by Jason Edward Johnson for a renewal of a manager's certificate to manage licenced premises known as Hopaholics Brewery and Hopaholics Taproom.

It was filed with the Grey District Council and is to be considered under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and by the District Licensing Committee.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant holds the Licence Controller Qualification. The applicant has previously held a General Manager's Certificate under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector has opposed this application. No undertakings are sought by the agencies.

Accordingly, the application is dealt with on the papers.
