**BEFORE THE GREY DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE**

This is an application by Po Kei Lau for a renewal of a manager's certificate to manage licenced premises known as the Railway Hotel, Greymouth.

It was filed with the Grey District Council and is to be considered under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and by the District Licensing Committee.

The applicant had her Managers Licence suspended for 28 days in February 2021 relating to a breach of compliance in September 2020.

**REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The applicant has undergone further training since her compliance breach.

The Licensing Inspector reports that there have been no reported incidents since September 2020, and that the applicant has managed the Railway Hotel in a satisfactory manner since then.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector has opposed this application. No undertakings are sought by the agencies.

The applicant holds the Licence Controller Qualification. The applicant has previously held a General Manager's Certificate under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Accordingly, the application is dealt with on the papers.

**DECISION**

The application and supporting information satisfies the committee that the criteria we must have in regard to as set out in s227 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Po Kei Lau for a renewal of a Manager's Certificate.
