

Decision No. GREYDLC 016/2023

IN THE MATTER

of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act)

AND

IN THE MATTER

of an application by **TYE DAVID JOHN HIBBS** pursuant to s.219 of the Act for a Manager's Certificate

BEFORE THE GREY DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

This is an application by Tye David John Hibbs for a manager's certificate to manage licensed premises known as "New World Greymouth".

Pursuant to s222 of the Act this application is to be considered under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and by the District Licensing Committee.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant holds the required Licence Controller Qualification and is employed on licensed premises.

The Licensing Inspector has tested the applicant's understanding of his responsibilities as a manager. He does not oppose the application, however he outlines in his report the applicant's lack of experience in controlling licensed premises. The Licensing Inspector is seeking an undertaking from the applicant that his Managers certificate is valid only at his current place of employment, New World Greymouth, to enable him to gain more experience.

An undertaking has been signed by the applicant stating he will only use his licence at New World Greymouth, and at no other licensed premises until the undertaking has been removed. He understands his obligations in regards to this.

The applicant has provided the committee with evidence of further experience and training at his place of employment. This has taken place between 27 October 2022 and 6 December 2022.

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the granting of the application.

Accordingly, the application is dealt with on the papers.

DECISION

The application and supporting information satisfies the committee that the criteria it must have in regard to as set out in s222 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Tye David John Hibbs for a Manager's Certificate.

It shall be recorded on the certificate **UNDERTAKING GIVEN refer decision of the Grey District Licensing Committee GREYDLC 016/2023.**

The Certificate is valid for twelve months from the date the certificate is issued.
