Decision No. GREYDLC 017/2023

IN THE MATTER of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol

Act 2012 (the Act)

AND

IN THE MATTER of an application by AIMEE

WINTER pursuant to s.219 of the

Act for a Manager's Certificate

BEFORE THE GREY DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

This is an application by Aimee Winter for a manager's certificate to manage licensed premises known as "New World Greymouth".

Pursuant to s222 of the Act this application is to be considered under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and by the District Licensing Committee.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant holds the required Licence Controller Qualification and is employed on licensed premises.

The Licensing Inspector has tested the applicant's understanding of her responsibilities as a manager. He does not oppose the application, however he outlines in his report the applicant's lack of experience in controlling licensed premises. The Licensing Inspector is seeking an undertaking from the applicant that her Managers certificate is valid only at her current place of employment, New World Greymouth, to enable her to gain more experience.

An undertaking has been signed by the applicant stating she will only use her licence at New World Greymouth, and at no other licensed premises until the undertaking has been removed. She understands her obligations in regards to this.

The applicant has provided the committee with evidence of further experience and training at her place of employment. This has taken place between 27 October 2022 and 26 January 2023.

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the granting of the application.

Accordingly, the application is dealt with on the papers.

DECISION

The application and supporting information satisfies the committee that the criteria it must have in regard to as set out in s222 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Aimee Winter for a Manager's Certificate.

It shall be recorded on the certificate UNDERTAKING GIVEN refer decision of the Grey District Licensing Committee GREYDLC 017/2023.

The Certificate is valid for twelve months from the date the certificate is issued.
