This is an application by Robert Scott Newcombe for a manager's certificate to manage licensed premises known as "Formerly the Blackball Hilton", Blackball.

Pursuant to s222 of the Act this application is to be considered under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and by the District Licensing Committee.

## **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The applicant holds the required Licence Controller Qualification and is employed on licensed premises.

The applicant previously held a managers certificate with the Grey District Council which expired on 7 February 2023 and was not renewed in time.

The Licensing Inspector outlines in his report the applicant's experience in controlling licensed premises and has tested the applicant's understanding of his responsibilities as a manager. He does not oppose the application.

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the granting of the application.

Accordingly, the application is dealt with on the papers.

## **DECISION**

The application and supporting information satisfies the committee that the criteria it must have in regard to as set out in s222 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Robert Scott Newcombe for a Manager's Certificate.

The Certificate is valid for twelve months from the date the certificate is issued.
