## BEFORE THE GREY DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

This is an application by Tin Trong Nguyen for a manager's certificate to manage licensed premises known as "Superliquor", Greymouth.

Pursuant to s222 of the Act this application is to be considered under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and by the District Licensing Committee.

## **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The applicant holds the required Licence Controller Qualification and is employed on licensed premises.

The Licensing Inspector outlines in her report the applicant's experience in controlling licensed premises and has tested the applicant's understanding of his responsibilities as a manager. She does not oppose the application.

The Licensing Inspector had initially sought an undertaking from the applicant to only use his managers certificate at Super Liquor Greymouth to enable further training and support, however, as he has now more experience since he was first interviewed, the inspector has advised this committee that the undertaking is no longer necessary.

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the granting of the application.

Accordingly, the application is dealt with on the papers.

## **DECISION**

The application and supporting information satisfies the committee that the criteria it must have in regard to as set out in s222 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Tin Trong Nguyen for a Manager's Certificate.

The Certificate is valid for twelve months from the date the certificate is issued.
