This is an application by Alan Bernard Monk for the renewal of his manager's certificate to manage licenced premises known as "Paroa Hotel", Paroa.

It was filed with the Grey District Council and is to be considered under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and by the District Licensing Committee.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant holds the required Licence Controller Qualification and has previously held a General Manager's Certificate under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

The applicant had his manager's certificate suspended from 11 November 2024 to 8 December 2024, and the Paroa Hotel's on-licence suspended from 15 November to 18 November 2024, after an application to ARLA by Police.

The Licensing Inspector, in her report, states that the applicant respected the decisions made by ARLA and learned from the disciplinary action imposed on him. She does not oppose the application.

The Police do not oppose this application and no undertakings are sought by the agencies.

DECISION

The application and supporting information satisfies the committee that the criteria we must have in regard to as set out in s227 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Alan Bernard Monk for the renewal of his Manager's Certificate.

Due to the circumstances involved, **should an incident occur relating to any breaches of the applicants managers certificate, the applicant will be brought before the DLC and this matter will be reheard subject to Section 201(4) of the Act.**
