**NOTICE OF DISAPPROVAL OF THE APPOINTMENT OF (ACTING/TEMP MGR
NAME) AS AN ACTING/TEMPORARY MANAGER**

1. The Committee refuses the appointment of Stacey Anne Harvey to be an acting manager at premises known as the "Blackball Workingmens Club" located at 19 Hart Street, Blackball. The licence holder for this club-licence premises is Blackball Workingmens Club and Mutual School of Arts Incorporated, licence number 55/CLUB/84/2015.
2. On 20 June 2025 Blackball Workingmens Club and Mutual School of Arts Incorporated notified the Committee under section 231 of the Act that it was appointing Stacey Anne Harvey as an acting manager at the premises known as the "Blackball Workingmens Club".
3. The 20 June 2025 was a public holiday, namely Matariki Day.
4. On 24 June 2025 the Police notified the Committee that they opposed the appointment of Stacey Anne Harvey as an acting manager on the grounds that she is not suitable to be employed as an acting manager. The Police provided a written submission in support of their opposition and outlined their concerns to the Committee.
5. The appointment of the acting manager started on 23 June 2025, and ends on 3 August 2025. The reason for the appointment given by the licensee is cover for their duty manager, Julie Mazey, who is on holiday.

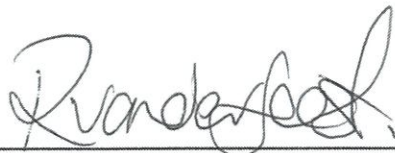
6. Section 231(4) and (5) of the Act provide that:

(4) The licensing committee may, within 5 working days after receiving a notice of the appointment of any temporary manager or acting manager, notify the licensee that it does not approve the appointment, in which case it must give a copy of the notice to the constable referred to in subsection (2)(b).

(5) On receiving notice under subsection (4), the licensee must terminate the appointment with effect from a date not later than 5 working days after the date of the notice.

7. The Committee has considered the Police opposition to this appointment and based on the information before the Committee, we consider that this provides sufficient basis not to approve the appointment under section 231(4) of the Act.
8. Having regard to the relevant provisions of the Act, we give notice under section 231(4) of the Act that we **do not** approve the appointment of Stacey Anne Harvey as an acting manager at this premises.
9. In accordance with section 231(5) of the Act, the licensee on receiving this notice must terminate the appointment of Stacey Anne Harvey as an acting manager **no later than 5 working days after the date of the notice.**
