This is an application by Glenn Kevin HOPPING for the renewal of his manager's certificate to manage licensed premises known as "The Duke Hostel", Greymouth.

It was filed with the Grey District Council and is to be considered under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and by the District Licensing Committee.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant holds the required Licence Controller Qualification and has previously held a General Manager's Certificate under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector has opposed this application. No undertakings are sought by the agencies.
