

Decision No. GREYDLC060/2021

**IN THE MATTER**

of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act)

**AND**

**IN THE MATTER**

of an application by **SATHVIKA ENTERPRISES LIMITED** for the renewal of an On Licence pursuant to 127 of the Act in respect of premises situated at the 84 Tainui Street, Greymouth, known as the "Priya Indian Restaurant".

**BEFORE THE GREY DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE**

Sathvika Enterprises Limited has applied for a renewal of ON Licence in respect of premises situated 84 Tainui Street Greymouth, known as "Priya Indian Restaurant".

The Premises hold an On-Licence No 055/ON/10/2014.

The applicant is a Private Company Incorporated on 21 February 201, number 4985820, the directors, and shareholders are Ramesh Alla and Ramadevi Karnati.

The committee is satisfied as to the matters that it must have regard to as set out in sections 105,106 and 131 of the Act.

**REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The application was advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. The Committee has received a report on the application from the Grey District Council Inspector Bernadine Lombaard with no objections.

There were no objections received from the Police or Medical Officer of Health and no undertakings are sought by the agencies.

The applicants have been operating for the last 16 years and has not come to the notice of the reporting agencies.

The Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 sets out the considerations which must be taken by the District Licensing Committee, when considering any application for a licence to sell alcohol.

There is no evidence before the Committee which would suggest that the applicant would manage the premises in any way which would contravene the requirements of the Act.

I am satisfied that after reviewing the application with respect to the section 105 considerations, that the application for a renewal on-licence should be approved.

Accordingly I will deal with the matter on the papers.

## **DECISION**

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **grants** an application by Sathvika Enterprises Ltd for a renewal of an ON licence for the premises at 84 Tainui Street, known as the "Priya Indian Restaurant".

1. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

**Monday to Sunday 9am to 12midnight.**


2. No liquor is to be sold or supplied on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00pm on ANZAC Day to any person other than persons who are present on the premises for the purpose of dining.
3. The premises are undesignated.
4. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale of alcohol a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments.
5. Water is to be provided freely at no cost to patrons from bottles provided on the dining tables.
6. Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises.
7. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises is open for the sale of alcohol, in accordance with the example menu submitted with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
8. The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
9. The following other steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
  - a. All service staff must be trained in their responsibilities under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
  - b. Evidence of age documents will be requested where appropriate.
10. The Licensee must ensure the following items are prominently displayed:
  - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
  - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
  - c. A copy of the licence, and of the conditions of the licence, attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises.
  - d. A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are

open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.

11. The licence is subject to the payment of licence fees as required by the Sales and Alcohol (fees) Regulations 2013.

**The premises are as set out on plans submitted with the application and date stamped 19 May 2021. A note to this effect is to be made on the licence.**
