

Decision No. GREYDLC 092/2021

BEFORE THE GREY DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

Superbrain Productionz Limited has made application for a special licence to sell and supply alcohol at 1 Tainui Street, Greymouth, known as the "Left Bank Art Gallery" to be held on Saturday 4 September 2021.

The event is being described as a "Theatre Performance" – (The Vagina Monologues) with Food and wine included in the ticket price.

This is a ticketed event with an estimated number of 50 people with probable age distribution of 18 to 80 years old.

The main principle entrance way to the premises is from the Town Square in the shared Tainui Street.

The applicant is a company with the shareholders being Jamie Lorene Mosher and Cary Lee Lancaster.

The applicant has applied for an exemption from having a certified manager on duty,

Under Section 213(2) the licensing committee may exempt the holder of any Special License from the requirement of appointing at least 1 Manager, if it is satisfied that the licensee will manage the conduct of the sale of alcohol pursuant to the licence.

Cary Lee Lancaster will be on duty for the duration of this licence and he has more than 30 years' experience running music and theatre events. He is currently training for his managers certificate and understands the object of the act.

The Licensing inspector has no issues with Cary Lancaster being responsible for the sale and supply of alcohol activities for this event therefore, the Licensing Committee accepts Superbrain Productionz Ltd request for an exemption from having a Certified Manager

DECISION

The Grey District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Superbrain Productionz Limited for an on-site Special Licence for premises situated at 1 Tainui Street, Greymouth for the "Theatre Performance" – (The Vagina Monologues) subject to the following conditions:

Conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days during the following hours:

Saturday 4 September – 7pm to 9.30pm

2. The premise area be designated as supervised for the licence period and is shown on the plan attached to this licence.
3. The licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises.
4. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcoholic beverages.
5. Cary lee Lancaster is to be on duty for the duration of the event
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises.
7. Drinking water is to be provided free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
8. The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licenced premises.
9. Payment of the fee prescribed under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Fees) Regulations 2013.

The premises are as set out on the plan submitted with the application and date stamped 9 August 2021. A note to this effect is to be made on the licence.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant has held a previous special licence with no issues reported and has appropriate systems and training to comply with the act.

The applicant has undertaken in their application to provide the following measures with regard to responsible sales or supply of alcohol and that harm will be minimised:

- Food in the form of Grazing Tables will be available throughout the event.
- Free water will be available at no charge throughout the event with signage to show where.

- Non alcoholic and low alcoholic beverages will be available.

It is noted that as there is no certified duty manager, the holder of the special licence, Cary Lee Lancaster, will hold full authority for the management and monitoring of alcohol consumption.


The Inspector's report indicates that the amenity and good order of the locality will not be adversely affected by more than a minor extent, and she does not oppose the application.

The Police and Medical Officer of Health raise no matters in opposition.

The application was not required to be publicly notified and no opposition or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly I deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act.
