

Decision No. GREYDLC 142/2021

IN THE MATTER

of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act)

AND

IN THE MATTER

of an application by the **SUPERBRAIN PRODUCTIONZ LIMITED** pursuant to s.138 of the Act for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 70 Mawhera Quay, Greymouth known as "The Town Square"

BEFORE THE GREY DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

Superbrain Productionz Limited has made application for a special licence to sell and supply alcohol at 70 Mawhera Quay, Greymouth, known as the "Town Square.

Friday 31 December 2021	7pm to 12.30am the following day	the	Greymouth BPA New Years Eve Celebrations

The event is for the New Year Eve Celebrations and includes live music.

This event has an estimated number of 60 people attending with a probable age distribution of 18 to 80 years old.

The premises will be designated restricted.

The premises is a fenced off grass area in the Town Square with the principal entrance being from Tainui Street.

The applicant is a company number 7321118 with the shareholders being Jamie Lorene Mosher and Cary Lee Lancaster.

DECISION

The Grey District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Superbrain Productionz Limited for an on-site Special Licence for premises situated at 70 Mawhera Quay, Greymouth for the "Greymouth BPA New Year's Eve Celebrations subject to the following conditions:

Conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days during the following hours:

Friday 31 December 2021	7pm to 12.30am the following day	the	Greymouth BPA New Years Celebrations

2. The fenced grass area be designated as restricted for the licence period and is shown on the plan attached to this licence.
3. The licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises.
4. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcoholic beverages.
5. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed at the premises.
6. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.

Minors and intoxicated persons must not be served alcohol.

7. Food must be available for consumption on the premises.
8. Drinking water is to be provided free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
9. The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licenced premises.
10. Payment of the fee prescribed under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Fees) Regulations 2013.

The premises are as set out on the plan submitted with the application and date stamped 19 November 2021. A note to this effect is to be made on the licence.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant has held a previous special licence with no issues reported and has appropriate systems, staff and training to comply with the act.

The applicant has undertaken in their application to provide the following measures with regard to responsible sales or supply of alcohol and that harm will be minimised:

- Food in the form of various Food Stalls will be available throughout the event.
- Free water will be available at no charge throughout the event with signage to show where.
- Non alcoholic and low alcoholic beverages will be available.
- Experienced security staff will be on the premises for the duration of the licence

There will be 3 experienced Duty Managers on duty for the event.

The fencing surrounding the licensed area will be 180cm high with one entry/exit point.


The Inspector's report indicates that the amenity and good order of the locality will not be adversely affected by more than a minor extent, and that the applicant is suitable to hold a licence and he does not oppose the application.

The Police and Medical Officer of Health raise no matters in opposition.

The application was not required to be publicly notified and no opposition or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly I deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act.
