of an application **by TRAPPERS LIMITED** pursuant to s.138 of the Act for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises situated at South Belt South Moana with the premises known as the "Blackball Domain".

BEFORE THE GREY DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

Trappers Ltd has made an application for a special licence for a Fundraiser/Family Day out. The event is known as "The Blackball Fair".

This application is for an Off-site Special Licence as per Section 22(5) of the Act. The applicant holds an On Licence 56/ON/072/2021 for the business known as the Woodstock Hotel Ltd.

The premises is known as the Blackball Domain and is situated at Town Belt South, Blackball.

The applicant has been approved to be a Stall Holder.

The main principal entranceway is from Town Belt South, Blackball.

The Domain area will be fenced with a 6-foot-high deer fence, with only one entrance to the area, as per the attached site plan. The Bar area inside the domain will be fenced.

The estimated number of people attending will be less than 100 with a probable age distribution of 0 to 65 years old.

DECISION

The Grey District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Trappers Ltd for an off-site Special Licence for the premises known as the Blackball Domain at Town Belt South, Blackball for a fundraising event subject to the following conditions:

Conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days during following hours.

2. The bar area and small fenced area in front of the bar will be classed as Supervised for the licence period and is shown on the plan attached to this licence.
3. A certified duty manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
4. The licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcoholic beverages.
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises.
7. Drinking water is to be provided free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
8. The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licenced premises.
9. Noise levels are to be monitored at all times.
10. Payment of the fee prescribed under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Fees) Regulations 2013.

The premises licensed area is set out on the plan submitted with the application and date stamped 27 January 2022. A note to this effect is to be made on the licence.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant has undertaken in their application to provide the following measures with regard to the responsible sales or supply of alcohol, and that harm will be minimised:

- Food stalls will be available during the event.
- Free water will be available at no charge throughout the event from the bar area.
- Non-alcoholic and low alcoholic beverages will be available.
- A courtesy van is available.

A certified manager will be on duty for the duration of the event

The Inspector's report indicates that the amenity and good order of the locality will not be adversely affected by more than a minor extent and that the applicant is suitable to hold this licence. The Inspector does not oppose this application.

The Police and Medical Officer of Health raise no matters in opposition.

Section 149(2) notes if a special licence issued is postponed to some other day, the licence is in force on the day on which the event or part takes place.

Vaccine Passes are required for Stall Holders and attendees of this event and will be checked at entry.

Accordingly, I deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act.
