This is an application by Suzanne Joan Rockhouse (the applicant) pursuant to Section 136 of the Act for a Temporary Authority Order in respect of the Ahaura Hotel (the licensed premises) situated at 3344 Clifton Street, Ahaura.

DECISION OF THE GREY DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

The application for a Temporary Authority Order (Temporary Authority) by the applicant in respect of licensed premises situated at 3344 Clifton Street, Ahaura to sell and supply alcohol from the premises is **granted**. The Temporary Authority may issue from commencement date of 31 March 2022 and will expire on 30 June 2022.

CONDITIONS

The licensee must comply with the conditions set out in the base On-licence for the premises, licence number 055/ON/45/2017.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant entered into a purchase agreement for the premises on 8 February 2022.

The applicant holds a current managers certificate with the Hurunui District Licensing Committee, number 57/CERT/911/2016.


There is no evidence before the Committee that would suggest the applicant would manage the premises in any way that would contravene the requirements or intention of the Act, or would suggest a temporary authority should not be granted.

Section 136 of the Act provides the Committee with the ability to set any conditions that should apply to the premises operating under a Temporary Authority. In this case the conditions set out in the base on-licence (055/ON/45/2017) continue to apply.

CONCLUSION

Having regard to the relevant provisions of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Committee is satisfied that a Temporary Authority Order should be granted, subject to the conditions set out in the licence 055/ON/45/2017.
