Hi Mark and Tony,

We continue to liaise with Ngati Waewae, and in the interim we have proposed some minor amendments to consent conditions which are shown in tracked changes on the attached set of conditions. These are to directly address their cultural concerns regarding mixing of waters between catchments.

This clarifies that water will not be taken from Canoe Creek for creek augmentation, only for operations. And mine water will only be discharged from the infiltration basin to Canoe Creek in heavy rainfall events, as defined in the attached conditions. These changes will be achieved by installing additional water treatment infrastructure at the plant site, however this means that the NTU and TSS water quality discharge standards must be amended slightly to reflect what is achievable with this infrastructure.

Would you please both consider the application amended to include these revised conditions.

Between now and the hearing, the Erosion and Sediment Control Plan and the Water Management Plan will be updated to reflect these changes.

We have now received Brett Sinclair's latest comments on the peer review response, and the company would like for both Councils to proceed to publicly notify the consent at the earliest opportunity.
