Paparoa Beach Hideaway submission

As the business owners of a commercial accommodation business on the stunning coast road we oppose the application due to subsequent reputational damage to the entire area from the industrial scale of this proposed operation. From the safety of all people using the highway, to the known fragility of the highway. Large investment is being made in promoting the Pounamu pathway for visitors to this region and this will make this pathway incredibly dangerous without huge investment in the highway itself.

The resource consent required by our business attracts an annual fee collected by the Gey District Council as an economic development fee for the promotion of tourism in our area. A granting of Resource Consent to tiga minerals will have Negative effects on tourism businesses in the Barrytown/Punakaiki area and will harm our Brand which the District and Regional councils and us have already invested vast sums of finance and resources into. We would be concerned with the potential negative effects on the 100% untamed brand which we pay the territorial authority to protect.

The scale of this mine will have huge negative effects on established business who are already contributing significantly to the area, in rates, jobs and amenities.

Industrial scale mining will contradict and threaten the west coast regional council's development west coast own 'untamed natural wilderness strategy, which promotes the west coasts most valuable asset, the natural environment.

The Resource consent application is for a limited period only however, it hints at further expansion of the mining land area in the future and indeed will not be economically viable in its current incarnation. If an over seas company wants to extract minerals in a professionally run mining operation, they should be honest about exactly, what it is they are intending to do and seek consent for. The approach taken by tiga to gain consent is both insulting and unprofessional it reeks of dishonesty and an underhanded approach to take our Gold and other minerals which at the moment belong to all New Zealanders.
