FORMAL NOTICE

28 DAY COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENT

Grey District Council – Public Places Bylaw Enforcement

To: The Occupant

The Grey District Council has identified **rubbish, stored materials, and unregistered/unwarranted vehicles** placed on the **road reserve** adjoining your property. Road reserve is **public land** and must remain unobstructed, safe, and tidy at all times.

Under the *Grey District Council Public Places Bylaw* the following clauses apply:

- It is prohibited to **place or leave any litter, material, or thing** in a public place that may create a nuisance (Clause **4.1(a)**).
- It is prohibited to **deposit or allow any material or thing** to be placed onto a public place or road (Clause **4.1(e)**).
- A person must not **obstruct a public place** by placing or leaving any material or thing (Clause **5.1(b)**).
- Vehicles must not be **parked or left** on a public place except where specifically permitted (Clause **6.1(f)**).

Accordingly, **you are hereby given 28 days' notice** to:

1. Remove all rubbish and stored materials from the road reserve.
2. Remove all unregistered, unwarranted, or abandoned vehicles from the road reserve.
3. Restore the area to a clean and unobstructed condition.

Failure to comply within 28 days may result in **enforcement action**, including removal of vehicles or materials from the site and recovery of all associated costs, as authorised under the *Local Government Act 2002* and the *Public Places Bylaw*.
