- 1 The Panel is in the phase of reviewing its completed and lengthy decision. While the decision may be released on Tuesday, 23 April 2024 as hoped, it is probable the Panel will overshoot that date by a small margin as the review process follow its course.
- 2 Accordingly, and all in the circumstances including the complexity of the matter, it is reasonable to extend the date for releasing a decision by doubling the statutory period. Despite that, the decision will be released and as soon as possible.
