I oppose this application in it's entirety. My reasons are, but not limited to, the following :  
~ The Health and Safety of Coast Road users, and the effects on tourism. There is a reason most mining roads are wide and flat, and seperated from the public. And that is because the number 1 concern is public safety. In no sane world is the Coast Road fit for purpose for the required amount of trucking movements that are proposed. This is a disaster waiting to happen. Even a single axle, dual wheel truck has to cross the centre line at least 5 times on the road between Barrytown and Rapahoe. This is not acceptable 50 times a day, and I know of 4 bicycle touring companies that will take the Coast Road off its itinerary if this proposal goes ahead.  
~ Noise and Climate Pollution. There is absolutely no deep regard for the environment in this application. only superficial quarantees that bear no weight at all.
