I oppose the application because industrial mining in this area, of the scale proposed, would have significant, irreversible and widespread effects on people, local infrastructure and the environment.

1/ People.

The proposal will adversely affect individual and community health and wellbeing. SH6 will become more dangerous to users due to the hundreds of daily truck and transport movements associated with a mine. Noise and vibration from trucking will create stress and sleep deprivation for those nearby and on the transport route most days of the year from early till after dark.

The application entails greater risk to other road users due to heavy trucking impact on residential driveways, school bus routes, motorists, pedestrian and cyclist users both local and tourists.

The proposal would degrade the amenity values, natural character and environmental features of the area ruining its appeal and cherished qualities for residents, locals and tourists alike. This will adversely impact local tourism operators and accommodation providers.

2/ Local Infrastructure.

The proposal would damage SH6 affecting other users in an ongoing fashion

3/ the Environment

The proposal's intensive fossil fuel use and despoiling of the local ecosystems will generate large CO2 emissions at a time when these are supposed to be being reduced as stated in the Zero Carbon Act.

The proposal contravenes the West Coast Regional Council's own "Unlamed Wilderness" strategy which promotes the West Coast's environment as pivotal in tourism and recreational amenities.

The proposal is contrary to the objectives of many national, regional and district level policies designed to protect the environment.

The proposal will critically impact the threatened Westland Petrel breeding population through habitat destruction, noise and light pollution

The proposal is for an extractive, high carbon emitting, unsustainable, ecologically destructive, ugly industrial site in a fragile coastal area vulnerable to coastal erosion and increased rainfall as a predicted consequence of climate change
