Dear Resident

This notice constitutes an official warning under the Grey District Council Solid Waste Bylaw 2012

The wheelie bin and/or crate that you placed at the kerbside was red tagged today because it did not meet Council's approved terms and conditions of use for the service.

The following issues were identified:

Wheelie Bin

Crate

The wheelie bin is overfull, and the lid was not fully closed.

The wheelie bin is overweight (it exceeded 80kgs).

The wheelie bin missed collection because it was not put out by 7:00am on collection day.

The contents in the recycling bin aren't clean.

The wheelie bin contains unacceptable or prohibited items.

The wrong bin was put out today. (i.e., refuse on a recycling week or recycling on a refuse week).

The crate is overfull and unsafe to pick up.

The crate missed collection because it was not put out by 7:00am on collection day.

The contents in the crate aren't clean.

The crate contains unacceptable or prohibited items.

The crate was put out on the wrong week. (i.e., crate on a refuse week)

Action required:

Please remove the wheelie bin and/or crate from the kerbside and plan to deliver the contents to McLean's Pit Landfill & Recycling Centre. Or make it safe and compliant, and then place it out for collection on the next appropriate collection day.

Failure to adhere to the terms and conditions means your property's kerbside collection service could be terminated without further notice.
